PAYMENT ARRANGEMENTS

Butterfly Funerals Ltd will at all times provide a written estimate of all charges the client will be expected to settle. The estimate will only be valid on the day of completion and will be subject to change in accordance with the clients wishes. We request that a deposit be made 7 days before the date of your loved one's funeral takes place. The deposit we expect is the disbursement costs only. Butterfly Funerals will send a final account to the client within 5 working days of the service provided. Full settlement will be required within 7 days of the account. For unattended direct funerals, Butterfly Funerals will require payment in full 72 hours prior to the funeral taking place.

Payments can be made by Cash, Cheque (except for unattended direct funerals) or BACS.

We except DWP funeral payments, please discuss this with the funeral arranger/director.

¹ This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave.
